# Information for Parents - Outline Plan for Learning and Teaching

Topic / Project Title: Famous Scots

Context relevant to the children: We will begin the year by looking at sustainability as we carry out our class eco action plan before celebrating Scots week and researching famous Scottish/local people.

### Languages

### **Health & Wellbeing**




Mr Watson will be teaching PE on a Monday and Tuesday. Please ensure that your child has the appropriate kit and footwear. There will be a focus on gymnastics.
