Information for Parents - Outline Plan for Learning and Teaching

Topic / Project Title: Animals

Context relevant to the children: To allow P4 choice in their learning, this project was selected purely by the children based on their interests.

Languages

Reading: We are completing a novel studies on Roald Dahl's Matilda. We will explore chapter in detail.

Writing: We will be writing a story in a similar 'rags to riches' style as Cinderella.

Listening and Talking: Everyone in Primary 4 will have a go at saying a range of Scots words and phrases.

Spelling and Grammar: We will focus on aspects of punctuation and how to use commas in particular. Pupils will have weekly spelling words available on Seesaw.

Mathematics

Numeracy: P4 will start the period identifying aspects of their maths knowledge which require targeted support. This will inform learning and teaching in Period 6 and beyond.

After that, we will focus on learning linked to multiplication. This will involved a strong focus on building fluency and speed of recall of table facts and the introduction of written methods of multiplication and division.
