2. Log in to www.readingcloud.net

- If you don't know your username and password, please ask your teacher

3. Find the book on the Reading Cloud

- Enter the title or author of a book into the [Quick Search](#) box at the top of the page.

4. Click on the title / author to open more details.

After [searching for a book](#) and opening the record the resource details screen will be shown:

5. Click “Create Review”

6. Write or record your review!!
