Topic / Project Title: Toys

Context relevant to the children: Children will be learning all about toys! They will learn about different types of toys, old and new, and the forces which make them 'go'.

### Languages

**Reading:** Children will receive reading homework on a Monday along with key words and phonics homework. Within class we will be revising the difficult two letter phonic sounds and word building to help us sound out words.

**Writing:** we will continue to use Talk4Writing approaches within the classroom. This will include story mapping, re-telling stories, changing characters and setting from stories we have learnt. This then supports us when we come to creating our own story map / piece of writing.

## **Expressive Arts**

The children will experience a variety of art, music and drama this period. We will be linking our art lessons to our topic of toys and include some model making! Our drama will be based upon our work surrounding Emotion Works, we will be acting out different scenarios and sharing our opinions.

### Health & WellBeing

**Emotion Works:** We will be focusing on emotion words such as happy, sad and angry and learning how we identify different types of emotions and feelings. Children will learn to use different words to explain emotions and feelings and how to regulate them.


# **Mathematics**

### **Mathematics and Numeracy**

**Numeracy**: Children will be focussing on addition followed by subtraction. The children will be learning a variety of addition strategies, as well as the language of addition. Allowing them to problem solve and answer questions in a way best suited to them.

**Mathematics:** This period we will move on to learning about fractions. Children will learn about halves and quarters.





**Science** 

Linked to our topic of Toys children will be learning about various properties toys have: are they a push or pull toy? Do they float or sink? Etc. They will also be able to work in teams to design and create their own toys.
