## Information for Parents - Outline Plan for Learning and Teaching

Topic / Project Title: Space

Context relevant to the children: Earth, Sun and Moon

#### Languages

**Reading**: We are continuing to focus on our reading comprehension skills and deepening our understanding of text and author's style.

**Writing**: We will work on creating a descriptive setting through Talk4Writing. We will use an extract from 'Adventure at Sandy Cove' as a stimulus.

**Listening and Talking**: Children will be discuss and ask questions from topics that arise during daily Newsround viewing.

**Spelling and Grammar**: Each week we will focus on a specific spelling rule and children will be able to select words from two lists which they think will be most meaningful to them.

**French**: We will look at French vocabulary for clothing and use our knowledge of colours to describe clothing in French.

### **Mathematics**

**Numeracy**: Children will continue to develop their fluency with multiplication and we will use this knowledge to solve division problems. We will also look at using the standard written method for addition and subtraction.

**Mathematics**: We will develop our knowledge of 2D and 3D shapes and their properties. We will use the correct vocabulary to describe the features e.g. face, edge, corner. Children will finally create 2D tiling patterns.

**Mental Maths**: Daily opportunities to reinforce times tables facts and recall of addition and subtraction facts.

**Art**-The children will be working with the art specialist to develop their creative skills.

Children will be given the opportunity to cook as part of a small group.
