

Information for Parents - Outline Plan for Learning and Teaching

Topic / Project Title: Dinosaurs

Context relevant to the children: The children showed an interest at the start of the year in undertaking a Dinosaur topic. We have talked about what they already know and would like to find out.

Languages

Reading: We will be reading our ORT books in reading groups, and carrying out reading activities linked to these. We will be practising our key words in class.

Writing: We will use what we have learned about rhyming words and syllables to change the characters in our Katie Bairdie poem.

Listening and Talking: We will try to take notes from videos and texts about dinosaurs.

Spelling and Grammar: We will continue to learn new sounds each week.

French: We will learn the numbers 1-10 and colours in French this term.



Health and Wellbeing

P.E: We will be learning how to roll, jump, balance and make shapes with our body in Gymnastics. We will practise putting these movements together to create a sequence.

Internet Safety: We will look at a series of lessons on how to keep ourselves safe online.

Rights Respecting Schools: Articles 12 and 29 refer to children's rights to their opinions and feelings and to an education which teaches them to respect other people's feelings. We will be discussing and encouraging this through our topic work.

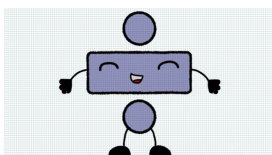

Numeracy: We will be continuing to revise addition and subtraction strategies and numbers to 100 and numbers to 1000. We will extend our learning of division by looking at division as grouping.

Mathematics: We will be looking at telling the time this term, using o'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to. We will identify am and pm times.
