Topic / Project Title: Forces

Languages



Reading: The class will continue to read their Reading Books in class on Wednesdays. Primary 3 have opportunities throughout the week for reading for enjoyment during quiet reading time.

Writing: P3 will continue to learn about instruction writing on Mondays. For our Talk for Writing lessons, P3 are continuing to explore the warning tale 'Kassim and the Greedy Dragon'. We will soon begin to plan, story map and create our own 'Warning Tales'.

Expressive Arts



Primary 3 will continue to practice developing rhythms on a range of instruments with Danny in our drumming sessions. Primary 3 are preparing for their performance on the 11th March.

Health & Wellbeing



PE: Primary 3 will developing their gymnastics skills this period. The children will work independently and in small groups to practice gymnastics moves and have the opportunity to create different sequences using a range of equipment.

Mathematics

Numeracy: This period, Primary 3 will learning about:

- Number Structures: Exploring the relationships between addition and subtraction sums
- Numerals: Identifying, ordering and comparing numbers up to and beyond 1,000.
- Division: Revisiting strategies for solving division sums.

Maths: Primary 3 will be learning about measure with Mr Watson this period.

RME



Judaism: Primary 3 will continue to learn about Judaism this period with Mr Watson, focussing on the religion's beliefs and practices. The class will also revisit the Easter Story.

Science

Our topic this period is a science focus on forces. Primary 3 will learn about different forces and will have the opportunity to take part in a range of different activities and experiments, investigating the forces of: push, pull, twist, squash and stretch
