Topic / Project Title: Emotion Works

Context relevant to the children: The children will begin to understand their emotions, reasons for feeling and reacting in different ways and follow the Emotion Works Recovery programme as we settle back into school.

Languages

Reading: We will be reading our chosen Class Novel Matilda. We will identify the main ideas through answering and asking questions about the text.

Writing: We will be writing about our experiences and discussing our feelings.

Listening and Talking: We will be developing our listening skills and responding to each other with questions that will develop our understanding.

Spelling and Grammar: We will continue to learn new sounds each week. We will be continuing to practise capital letters, full stops and finger spaces in our writing.

French: We will continue to develop our confidence by listening to and responding in French.


Expressive Arts

The children will be building on their ability to express their thoughts and feelings through Art. They will be responding to Art and Music with their opinions and learning how to give and receive constructive criticism respectfully.



Social Studies

Alongside our Emotion Works programme, we will begin to understand the needs and wants of others and how these may vary from our own. We will be exploring rules and responsibilities as we develop our Classroom Charter.



Health & Wellbeing

Health: Through the Emotion Works Recovery programme we will be learning to recognise our emotions, responses and how to manage the triggers that may cause these.

PE: We will be developing our fitness levels and refining our skills as we recognise the need to keep our bodies moving.

Rights Respecting Schools: Primary Three will be exploring their rights, rules and responsibilities as we develop our Classroom Charter.

Mathematics

Numeracy: We will be practising and consolidating our number knowledge, place value and the four operations (Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication and Division).

Mathematics: We will be focusing on Shape in our Maths lessons and exploring a variety of 2D and 3D shapes. We will investigate tiling to discover how shapes can fit together to create patterns.



Technologies

Primary Three will begin to understand why and how we can be safe online as they explore Digital Technologies to further their learning.

The children will learn to recognise differences between individual beliefs whilst learning to respect and celebrate these. The children will develop their awareness of values such as caring and sharing and demonstrate these throughout their learning.
