Information for Parents - Outline Plan for Learning and Teaching

Topic / Project Title: The Romans

Languages

Reading: We will read information about the Romans and take notes to show our understanding. We will use these notes to support our learning throughout our topic.

Writing: We will learn a new text and through Talk for Writing, will adapt the story with our own ideas.

Listening and Talking: We will be developing our confidence in reading aloud with expression. We will demonstrate our topic knowledge through preparing and sharing a solo talk.

Spelling and Grammar: We will continue to learn new sounds each week. We will be continuing to practise capital letters, full stops and finger spaces in our writing.

French: We will continue to develop our confidence by listening to and responding in French. We will be learning to identify classroom objects in French.

Expressive Arts

The children will begin to record their learning through Art. Primary Three will create informative posters, sketches and designs to share their learning across the curriculum.

The children will explore script reading and through drama, will recreate historical events.

Social Studies

We will explore the history of Scotland during the Roman Empire and carry out comparisons to the Scotland we now know. We will explore our local setting and the impact that historical events have had on our lives.

Health & Wellbeing

Health: We will be continuing our Emotion Works programme by learning how to control and cope with our emotions. We will learn to identify people who can help us. **PE**:We will be following instructions carefully, giving and accepting feedback and repeating movements to develop our Athletic skills.
