

Information for Parents - Outline Plan for Learning and Teaching

Topic / Project Title: Influential People Through Time

Context relevant to the children: Please remember to have a reading book in class to read each day and complete book reviews on.

Languages

Reading: Continuing Class novel on the 'Underground to Canada'. Creating book reviews from books children have read in class.

Writing: Talk for writing based on figurative language, focussing on the short story of 'Forever Boy'

Listening and Talking: Daily discussions and quizzes based on watching Newsround daily.

Spelling and Grammar: Continuing to learn different spelling patterns each week with a mini assessment each Friday.

French: Continue to practise French phrases with the register and begin to expand these phrases so their vocabulary can improve.

Expressive Arts

Music: A series of lessons on musical appreciation.

Art: Primary 6 will receive art lessons from an art specialist.

Social Studies

Continuing to look at historical figures from the past, who have helped to change society to how we see it today.

Health & Wellbeing

Health: Emotions works recovery programme to welcome back pupils to school.

PE: A series of basketball lessons with a focus on tactics.

Rights Respecting Schools: Linked to social studies topic about the basic rights people have.

Mathematics

Numeracy: Revising division facts and using these to help solve word problems.

Mathematics: A small topic on coordinates. Focussing on plotting coordinates on grids.

Technologies

Continue to use iPads and computers to research people for our topic.
