Topic / Project Title: Houses and Homes

Context relevant to the children: The children will be learning about different types of housing in various climate zones and communities.

Languages



Reading: We will continue to read regularly in class, discussing what we have read and answering questions on the text.

Writing: We will continue to write Weekend News weekly and the children will become familiar with Instructional Writing.

Listening and Talking: Children will be expected to contribute effectively to class discussions and share information about our Topic of Houses and Homes.

Spelling and Grammar: We will be learning about a variety of spelling and grammar rules this period.

French: The children will continue to learn basic French vocabulary and be able to identify simple phrases.

Mathematics

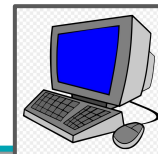


Numeracy: The children will continue to work with numbers up to and beyond 100. We will be focusing on estimating and rounding numbers to the nearest 10.
