# Information for Parents - Outline Plan for Learning and Teaching

**Topic Title:** Our Local Community

**Context relevant to the children:** The Children will explore the local area, environment and landscape. They will begin to think about the needs of the community and school as they develop their sense of place.

## Languages

**Reading**: We will be reading a variety of fiction and non-fiction texts as a class. We will continue to develop our note taking skills using the information we find.

**Writing**: We are developing our presentation skills, ensuring our sentence formation and handwriting is accurate.

**Listening and Talking**: Primary Three will be building their listening skills and making notes on the information they are given.

**Spelling and Grammar**: We are continuing to use our knowledge of phonics to read and write tricky words.

**French**: We will be revising how to discuss the weather, days and months in French.

## **Mathematics**

**Numeracy**: Primary Three will be building on their prior learning, using mental and written strategies for addition and subtraction with numbers to 100 and beyond.

**Mathematics**: We will be focusing on measure. We will be using our estimation skills alongside the appropriate tools to weigh and measure different quantities and lengths.



## **Expressive Arts**

Primary Three will have the opportunity to work with Ms Goodwin to develop their artwork this term. We will use sketches to support our topic learning as we create maps of the local streets and area.



#### Social Studies

Following on from our Romans topic where we particularly enjoyed learning about local history, we will be investigating our local community further. We will research the landscape, land use, housing and community needs. We will develop maps of our local area and begin to build our sense of place.
