Topic / Project Title: How Transport has developed over time.

Languages

Reading: Starting a new class novel of 'Varjack Paw'
Writing: Talk for writing based on creating suspense, focussing on the short story of 'Zelda Claw and the Rain Cat'
Listening and Talking: Daily discussions and quizzes based on watching Newsround on a daily basis. Daily listening exercises will be carried out as well.
