As per the letter of 2 February to parents and carers from Fiona Robertson, Executive Director Children, Young People and Partnerships, children are on holiday next week and on Monday 15 February.

Please note that there will be no provision for vulnerable children and key worker children in schools during the February break and on the inservice day on Monday 15 February.

On Tuesday 16 February, key worker and vulnerable children will continue to attend under the same arrangements as they have been since 6 January.

Later on Monday 15 February, Class Teachers will send details of any Class Google Meets / 'check ins' and online learning for the week starting on Tuesday 16 February. On Tuesday 16 February, we are expecting the First Minister to confirm whether or not the suppression of COVID-19 allows the full return of Early Learning and Childcare (ELC) and Primaries 1, 2 and 3 to schools and ELC settings from Monday 22 February. Midlothian Education will issue information as soon as possible following any announcement by the Scottish Government. In order to access the live 'check in', your child will need THEIR GLOW login details. If you use the log in details of a Parent / Carer, the Teacher will not admit you to the children's live 'check in' Google Meet. This may involve Parents / Carers signing out of their own Google applications before your child logs on.
