Information for Parents - Outline Plan for Learning and Teaching

Topic / Project Title: Keeping Safe

Languages

Reading: We are going to continue following the Oxford Reading Tree scheme for reading in class and at home. A copy of the book and Key Stage Words will be sent home each week to practice.

Writing: The children will take part in a range of writing activities each day during their Literacy rotations.

Spelling and Grammar: We are following the Jolly Grammar 1 framework for phonics and grammar. Over the next few weeks the children will revise/learn these sounds: **sh, ch, th, qu.** For grammar, our focus will be on recognising and writing capital letters.

Expressive Arts

This period Primary 2 will receive Art lessons from Miss Goodwin. The children will have the opportunity to learn about colour, shape, line and patterns through a range of different materials. Primary 2 will also receive Music lessons from Ms McInroy on a Thursday afternoon. They will have the opportunity to use their voice and a range of instruments to copy and compose pieces of music.

Topic

The children will be learning to assess and manage risk to protect themselves and others. They will know how to react and respond in unsafe situations and emergencies. We will look at the importance of a range of jobs in relation to keeping people safe.

Mathematics Keeping Safe

Numeracy: We will do a range of activities to practice counting to 100 such as identifying numbers, putting numbers in order, recognising numbers before and after. We will also revise a range of subtraction strategies to answer sums from 20/30.

Mathematics: We will be learning about money this period. Children will experience how to pay for items using different coins up to the value of 20p. We will also learn about giving and receiving change.







PE: Primary 2 will take part in PE lessons on a Tuesday and Wednesday. Lessons will focus on following instructions and learning how to cope and act appropriately when winning or losing.

Health & Wellbeing

Rights Respecting Schools: The children will consolidate their understanding about their rights and collaboratively design a Class Charter in line with the Tynewater Values and their rights.
