Information for Parents - Outline Plan for Learning and Teaching

Topic / Project Title: Keeping Myself and Others Safe

Context relevant to the children: The children will be learning about how to approach and react to unsafe and emergency situations. We will be carrying out role-play scenarios to allow the children to take on a range of roles and discuss their thoughts and feelings.

Languages

Reading: The children will focusing on reading with fluency and flow as well as understanding text and learning strategies to find information.

Writing: The children learning to write with more independence as well as use a range of words to connect different sentence together.

Listening and Talking: The children will be learning about verbal and non verbal communication both within and outside our classroom.

Spelling and Grammar: We will be continuing to progress through the Jolly Grammar framework for learning phonics.

French: We will be learning to count to 30 in French and all about French drinks.

Expressive Arts

Art: The children will be sharing their views appropriately about their own and others work using the correct vocabulary.

Drama: Through our topic we will taking on different roles in role-play scenarios. We will consider the use of expression, body language and facial expressions to engage the audience.


Health & Wellbeing

Teacher: Miss Thorburn

Health: The children will be learning to assess and manage risk to protect themselves and others. They will know how to react and respond in unsafe situations and emergencies. We will look at the importance of a range of jobs in relation to keeping people safe.

PE: Primary 2/3 will take part in PE lessons with Mr Watson and Miss Thorburn this period. Lessons will focus on following instructions and learning how to cope and act appropriately when winning or losing.

Rights Respecting Schools: The children will consolidate their understanding about their rights and collaboratively design a Class Charter in line with the Tynewater Values and their rights.





Mathematics

Numeracy: We will continue to broaden our understanding of number and place value. The children will be learning to count forward and backwards and recognise the value of each digit within a number.

Mathematics: The children will be learning to identify and use coins to pay for items. They will be exploring different ways to make the same total using correct notation.

Technologies

The children will be using Chromebooks and lpads to assist their learning within all areas of the curriculum.
