Do not build bonfires under overhead lines



Do not set fireworks off near or under overhead powerlines



Do not set fireworks off near substations



Ensure you are a safe distance from the electrical network so that no debris, smoke, heat or fire from the fireworks can damage the network or lead to serious injury

Setting off fireworks and having bonfires near overhead lines and substations can not only cause damage that can result in power cuts but can also potentially lead to serious injuries to people in the vicinity
