
Welcome back to P5H!

Numeracy & Maths

The children will continue to develop their skills in number sequences, number structures, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will have a strong focus on times tables this term, with the pupils practising their tables in different contexts such as board games, interactive games and written work. This knowledge of times tables will help them in our Maths topic of Fractions, where we will look at fractions on a number line, equivalent fractions and calculating fractions of amounts. Following this, we will move on to concentrate on Money.

Literacy

The pupils will continue their work in their Reading Teams which run across our P5 and P6 classes. Within writing, we will focus on making and using notes in addition to persuasive and discursive writing. This will also link to our learning in Listening and Talking, where children will take part in a debate as part of our topic on Fair Trade.

Topics

P5H thoroughly enjoyed our topic on Mary Queen of Scots and thoroughly impressed our guide with their knowledge when we visited Holyrood Palace before the October break. This term, we will focus on Fair Trade as our topic, using our research skills to find out more about ethical trading. We will also consider basic human needs and discuss why some societies can meet these needs more effectively than others. We also hope to make some Fair Trade products as part of our learning.

Our other topics this year will be:

- Healthy Body (Science)
- Other World Religions (RME)
- Forces and Electricity (Science)
