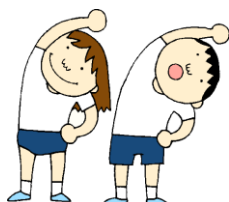
Spelling: This term there is a focus on using Fry's common words. These are words that are used most often in everyday reading and writing. Continued practice of these will help to develop both these areas. Each child will have individual word lists that they will be expected to practice in a variety of ways before being tested at the end of every 1-2 weeks. These word lists will be issued by the class teacher.

Homework grid: Another homework grid will be issued that allows your child to consolidate learning from different areas across the curriculum.
