


Learning Intention

To reinforce groupings within numbers to 12 To practice addition and subtraction facts to 20.

Aim of Game

First player/pair to cover all the fish on their game board.



Players need

Fish board (individually or in a pair)
Counters
Two 1—6 dice

Rules of the game

- 1. Roll the two dice and add the two numbers together.
- 2. Players get to cover up two numbers that make the total. For example: If total is 8 then could cover 1 and 7, 2 and 6, 5 and 3 or 4 and 4.
- 3. Cover one combination of numbers each roll.
- 4. If a player can't cover any numbers then they miss a turn.

Variations

- Cover more than two numbers per dice roll or as many combinations in one roll.
- Use of addition and subtraction combinations to make total.
